Graduate Faculty Status Criteria:

Level I:

- Terminal degree in discipline; and
- One of the following:
 - 2 peer-reviewed journal articles PLUS 2 peer-reviewed scholarly works. Such scholarly works may include peer-reviewed journal articles, book chapters, book review essays, receipt of one or more competitive grants, refereed conference proceeding papers, or state/national/international professional presentations accepted through a peer review.

OR

1 scholarly peer-reviewed book in faculty member's discipline or field of research

OR

 equivalent externally-recognized publication or creative activity appropriate to discipline

Level II:

- Terminal degree in discipline; and
- One of the following:
 - 1 peer-reviewed journal article, PLUS 1 peer-reviewed scholarly work as defined above in Level 1.

OR

equivalent externally-recognized publication or creative activity appropriate to discipline

Level III:

- Appropriate graduate degree; and
- 2 years of professional experience
